The Arc recently received several grants which we are so grateful for:

- The Story County Community Foundation— \$3,000 to assist with purchasing new t-shirts for our Special Olympics competitions.
- Theisen's Community Grant—\$1,000 to assist with several scheduled community activities such as the annual Fall Barbeque, transportation for State Bowling and the I-Cubs game, and renting canoes at Hickory Grove.
- Memorial Lutheran Church, Nevada—\$700 for two Chromebooks for the Project SEARCH Program.
